

2018 Scholarships - Cashiers United Methodist Church

Cashiers United Methodist Church (CUMC) makes limited single award scholarships to Cashiers area graduating seniors and 13th year graduates (Blue Ridge Early College - BREC) each year. The scholarship committee of CUMC determines the number of scholarships to be awarded to in any given year. They will conduct interviews of selected applicants and select scholarship recipients.

A **fully completed** Application Form, the required letters of recommendation, and an official copy of the applicant's high school transcript must be received by the Scholarship Administrator, listed below, **on or before April 6** to be considered by the scholarship committee.

Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, creed, gender, ethnic background, or handicap.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Greater Cashiers area residents
- High school or BREC graduate (12th or 13th grade)
- Homeschoolers whose home schools are registered with the NC Division for Non-Public Education
- Students who will attend a U.S. university, college, community college, technical or vocational school as a **full-time** student in the fall semester following the award

In addition, applicants must demonstrate:

- High moral character and demonstrated leadership qualities while in high school
- Potential for academic achievement and career growth
- Hard worker as indicated by class rank, GPA, and honor's curriculum
- Participation in school, extracurricular and work activities, and community service
